Essentially, for the research questions presented, an appropriate analysis about supply chain management is given with the use of a widely adopted SCOR model. However, manuscript needs more detailing on the use of statistical methods; more information must also be given concerning the SCOR performance metrics. In essence, the references are sufficient and relevant to the topic of the manuscript, covering essential aspects of supply chain management and food security. However, some references are rather outdated, and the inclusion of more recent studies from within the last five years could be considered in order to reflect more current thinking. Further reference suggestions may include recent publications on sustainable food systems and local food production innovations.	Revised according to reviewer's suggestions, marked in green
Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?	The quality of the language in this manuscript is essentially fit for scholarly communication, clear, and in no case obscure. The manuscript contains quite a number of very minor grammatical errors; besides, it contains several somewhat awkwardly phrased phrases. Since it could benefit from rewriting to make the reading easier, I would even advise an intensive proofreading session in order to achieve a fully readable quality of the language.
