Regarding in the materials and methods and in results paper author indicated so many trees and their data collection, if they could have added some illustrations/ pictures/ Graphs in discussion will be realistic and be in more scientific manner. References are crosschecked and as of me it is correct but one suggestion from me is, in introduction section lack of recent references, so many are older and very few recent ones are there if possible they might add and it would appreciable.

Minor revisions, such as simplifying complex sentences in the discussion section and ensuring consistent use of technical terms, could further enhance clarity and readability. For example, in table 5 in writing the botanical name as <i>Acronychia pedunculata</i>, the author had written or typo error as "<i>Acronychia pendunculata</i>"; and also in Table 6: inconsistent capitalization is there for writing the family name <i>Verbenaceae</i> appears as "verbenaceae" and in few places author gave Capitalize each word for headings that one needs to be checked; some many punctuation errors (Table1..) and grammatical mistakes also be there that needs to be corrected for better readability.</p>	<p>Revision made</p>
