From this study, I found that the findings can also contribute significantly to improve inclusive education and teacher training practices, although in this article I recommend further improvements in detail which is mentioned below.

	<ul> <li>Methodology section</li> <li>In study design the case study approach is well-justified, but additional rationale/causes for selecting Kitwe College of Education would strengthen this section.</li> <li>Sampling procedure is described well, but clarifies if gender balance or other diversity factors were considered.</li> <li>In data collection, procedure needs to be described how biases from interpreter-mediated focus groups were mitigated.</li> <li>The ethics section is strong.</li> </ul>
