I have read the corrected version of the article titled "Human Health Risk Assessment of Heavy Metals and Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons in Seafood from Southern Nigeria's Coastal Regions." However, it should be noted in Figure 3 that Iron and the other mineral elements cannot be presented on the same graph, as Iron is a heavy metal and therefore exists in trace amounts in living organisms. The authors should correct this by removing Iron and placing it in a table with the other trace elements.
