

Editor's Comment:

In the manuscript, the authors gave an Assessment of the Human Health Risk Assessment of Heavy Metals and Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons in Seafood from Southern Nigeria's Coastal Regions.

The purpose and objectives of the study have been fully accomplished.

The studies were conducted at a high scientific and methodological level.

The authors used modern equipment and research methods.

The obtained material has been statistically processed.

The text of the manuscript has a logical structure. The text is written in understandable English. The text contains a small number of spelling errors and typographical errors.

The results have a detailed, thorough analysis and are compared with available literary sources.

The authors do not allow the use of literary data without citing it.

The conclusion is consistent with the results obtained.

However, the following comments can be made.

1. The title of the manuscript does not correspond to the purpose of the study, which is in the abstract.
2. Abstract. There is no description of the assessment of the nutritional value of the products studied. If the purpose of the study in the abstract is correct!
3. Too many tabular data. Maybe we can reduce them and leave only the main ones!

The comments do not reduce the significance of the results obtained.

Correcting the comments will improve the quality of the manuscript and the interest of readers in it.

I recommend that you revise the manuscript.
