Optional/General comments	<p>If symptoms are because of adhesion/incisional hernia, what is the necessity of hysterectomy unless it is complicated.</p> <p>Given the possibility of infection in gynaecological procedures, it is not wise to include cosmetic and hernia surgery with them.</p> <p>Hysterectomy is not a procedure without morbidity to consider it as casual</p>	<p>Thank you for your thoughtful observation. In addition to the incisional hernia, the patient also had symptomatic uterine fibroids that required hospital admissions and blood transfusions. She had completed her desired family size and wanted a hysterectomy. She preferred to have the simultaneous operation which we worked towards achieving for her.</p> <p>We recognized the risk of infection associated with gynaecological procedures. Therefore, the surgery was carefully planned and executed to prevent infection and wound complications as detailed on pages 6 and 7 of the case presentation section.</p> <p>We were aware of the risks associated with hysterectomy and took necessary precautions to avoid them. These precautions included being meticulous during the surgery, changing the operating instruments after completing the gynaecological part of the procedure before moving on to other aspects, and using antibiotics appropriately.</p>
