Do you mean to say "dry and wet season"? If so, please specify the month of sowing for more clarity.</div> <div>3. It is better to write "root/root tuber" rather than just "tuber," as "tuber" is generally used to refer to a modified form of stem, like in the case of potato.</div> <div>4. In the sentence, "It is a good source of antioxidants, antimicrobial, antibacterial activity to the body which ends in promoting overall health," do you mean "aids" instead of "ends"?</div> <div>5. Chaudhari et al. (2022) observed greatest growth and yield of Radish at 20cm Greatest growth and were also obtained by Parajuli et al, (2023).In this sentence Instead of writing greatest use maximum. Read the sentence carefully and make necessary changes. The revised sentence: Chaudhari et al. (2022) observed maximum growth and yield of radish (<i>Raphanus sativus</i> L.) at 20 cm spacing, which was further supported by the findings of Parajuli et al. (2023), who also reported maximum growth and yield under similar conditions.</div> <div>6. There is paucity of information about spacing and plant method. In this sentence do you mean planting methods</div> <div>7. You wrote earthen up: Do you mean "earthing up"? If so, the revised sentence</div> <div>8. You wrote harvesting was done manually after the tubers matured. Please specify how many days after sowing the roots were harvested.</div> <div>9. You wrote highest number of number of leaves. It seems like the sentence has a repetition. Read carefully and rectify.</div> <div>10. whereas transplanted plants revealed wider canopy spread at the spacing of 15cm and 20cm under wet season. The correct phrase is "in the wet season.
