The Discussion section does not provide clear recommendations for clinical practice or future research based on the study's findings. The authors could have suggested how the identified liver biomarker patterns could inform clinical decision-making, such as screening, monitoring, or risk stratification of individuals with alcohol use disorders. Additionally, the authors could have identified potential areas for future research to address the limitations of the current study and further advance the understanding of the role of liver biomarkers in alcoholic liver disease.
