But there are afew things that could be done better: The opening sentence of the abstract does not provide a succinct overview of the study's importance. Protein content and other numerical facts are provided, however they need to be stated more succinctly. Sometypographical problems need to be fixed, such as missing spaces and improper capitalization. "Standard analytical procedures" are mentioned in the approach, however they are not defined.
