Suggestions for improvement:  Highlighting the broader impact: Incorporate terms like "sustainability," "alternative protein," or "nutritional potential" to emphasize the importance of edible insects in addressing global food challenges.  Avoiding redundancy: The phrase "commonly consumed insects in Nigeria" could be shortened for conciseness.  Suggested Title Option:  "Nutritional and Functional Characterization of Edible Insects in Nigeria: A Sustainable Protein Source"

However, it could benefit from some revisions to improve clarity and focus. Here are my suggestions:  Introduction Clarity: The opening sentence could be expanded to emphasize the broader significance of edible insects in global nutrition and sustainability, not just in Nigeria. For instance, you could mention their potential as alternative protein sources in the context of food security and environmental sustainability.  Detailed Results: While the abstract includes many numerical findings, it might be better to condense or summarize these to avoid overwhelming the reader. For instance, instead of listing all the specific moisture, lipid, protein, and carbohydrate contents, a general summary could suffice, such as "The insects exhibited high protein, lipid, and vitamin A contents, with significant variability among species."  Functional Properties: The abstract does not elaborate on the functional properties of the insects, even though they are mentioned in the study's aim. Including a brief mention of key findings related to functional properties would provide a more balanced overview.  Conclusion Strength: The conclusion could be more impactful by explicitly linking the results to potential applications, such as how these insects could be integrated into food systems or processed into value-added products.
