This article fills a critical knowledge gap in peace science. It advances theoretical and empirical research on an important question in the field of conflict resolution and peacebuilding contextually. Observing the increasing and persistent violent conflicts and insecurity in Africa despite the use of western mechanisms for conflict resolution and peacebuilding, the author interrogates the compatibility and effectiveness of these western approaches within the African realities. As such, the author challenges African scholars, universities, politicians and other key stakeholders to rethink conflict resolution and peacebuilding from an African indigenous perspective in order to enable local ownership and sustainability of peace processes in Africa. Therefore, the need to “Decolonize Peace” in Africa. Hence the article promotes the African Agency by advocating for “African solutions to African problems”. So instead of imposing western-style approaches, the more suitable thing to do is to remodel the “modern/western” approach to conflict resolution and peacebuilding by integrating the values of “African communalism” (I am because you are) for more unity, harmony and sustainable peace rather than “western individualism”: (you are because I am) which is at the heart of many divisions and violent conflicts in African societies.

I would even prefer the term “sustainable peace”. So the suggested title is either 1 or 2: 1. Decolonizing Peace: Why African Traditions Hold a Key to Sustainable Peace in Africa. Or 2. Decolonizing Peace in Africa: Why African Traditions Hold a Key to Sustainable Peace.

Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.	Yes Despite some few methodological and technical issues, the research articles meet the required scientific standard for published articles. It is theoretically and empirically sound and original.
