The current title focuses on the impact of COVID-19, which is only part of the study, as it also addresses long-term trends, interventions, and other challenges faced by the school. Suggested Alternative Title: "Enhancing Academic Performance in a Rural Private Primary School: Addressing COVID-19 Disruptions and Long-Term Challenges" This revised title reflects the study's focus on interventions and broader issues affecting academic performance while maintaining the emphasis on COVID-19.
