However, the study could be improved by expanding its scope, incorporating a gender perspective, and exploring external influences in greater depth. Despite its limitations, the paper provides important insights into the changing dynamics of rural life in Bangladesh and offers practical recommendations for policymakers and development practitioners.

For example, the perspectives of different demographic groups (e.g., youth, elderly, women) could have been explored more thoroughly to provide a richer understanding of the changes.
