Clinical and Diagnostic Details: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Expand on the differential diagnosis process. For example, what other pathologies (e.g., ossifying fibroma, fibrous dysplasia, lipoma) were considered, and how were they ruled out? ○ Specify the criteria used to diagnose the osteoma based on imaging and histopathology, if applicable. 3. Discussion Depth: <p>Elaborate on surgical details , The description of the bicoronal approach is thorough, but further details on the technical nuances, such as methods to control bleeding or avoid nerve injury, any intra operative challenges, histopathology report and image if possible would provide deeper insights for readers.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Ethical Considerations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ While the report mentions informed consent, it would be beneficial to state explicitly whether consent was obtained for the use of images and publication, adhering to journal requirements. <p>Minor Recommendations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Language and Grammar: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Revise for grammatical issues (e.g., "Despite it is a common bone pathology" should be "Despite being a common bone pathology"). ○ Enhance sentence structure to improve readability, especially in the abstract and discussion sections. 2. References: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Some references are older and may benefit from updated sources to ensure relevance. For example, reference 9 from 2002 could be supplemented with more recent literature on surgical techniques.
